

Instructions for Veterinary Practitioners:

This certificate template is to be used when examining and certifying mares or fillies for sale as potential breeding animals at Goffs Bloodstock sales.

This certificate should be printed on headed paper.

The identification of the horse is to be checked against the Passport. Where a microchip is present it should be read and the number, once verified against the Passport, should be recorded on the certificate together with the Passport Number.

The examination consists of seven possible stages. It must be indicated which stages of the examination were performed by deleting those not completed.

The veterinary practitioner may decide that it is unsafe or unnecessary to perform all of the stages described on the certificate in every case. This decision is left to their professional discretion, based on an assessment of each individual case.

The examining veterinary practitioner should clearly delete either "did" or "did not" in the final line of the certificate to indicate their opinion on the breeding suitability of the animal.

Any abnormal or unusual findings should be described in detail on the certificate.
